

Hello,

The election on 6th May is crucial; your vote can change Scotland's future. It will be **Scotland's choice: whether Scotland's destiny should be in Scotland's hands, or stay in Boris Johnson's**.

The choice in May is about who is best placed and trusted - nationally and locally - to lead our communities through the final stages of the pandemic; rebuild our economy; and face up to the challenges that lie ahead, including tackling the impact of Brexit.

Despite having to deal with COVID-19 and Brexit, the Scottish Government has delivered tremendous achievements in this last Parliament, including: nearly 3,000 'Baby Boxes' for Borders' parents; a 68% increase in superfast broadband coverage in the Borders, to reach 89%; invested £89m on new schools in the Borders; established Social Security Scotland and the new Scottish Child Payment worth £520 per year.

If re-elected, we will go further, including: doubling the Scottish Child Payment; building 100,000 new affordable homes; establishing a new National Care Service; and bringing ScotRail back into public hands. As part of ensuring our economic recovery, we'll create a new Rural Entrepreneurs' Fund to support 2,000 new businesses with up to £10,000 each; and we'll guarantee a place in education, work or training for every 16-24 year old in Scotland.

However much we might wish it away, Brexit impacts on local farmers, fish processors and businesses, every day. It was opposed by nearly two-thirds of Scots, but in an unequal UK, Scotland's voice was ignored by Boris Johnson. The election will not settle whether or not Scotland regains her independence, or her place in the EU - if re-elected, we intend that that will be for you to decide in a new vote, once the pandemic passes. However, the London-controlled parties all say they will neither rejoin the EU nor will they 'allow' Scots to chart a better course.

Leadership at a local level is crucial. I've lived in Berwickshire for 21 years and have been honoured to serve as an MSP for South Scotland since 2011 – working with local partners and agencies to get results. **My team in Hawick and I have helped or supported over 10,000 constituents since 2016.** I've brought to the role my experience as an economist and as a Minister, covering issues like business, innovation, justice, environment, digital connectivity, energy and climate change.

I've secured £133m in investment in gigabit speed broadband for South Scotland and two new 4G phone masts at Ettrick and Whitropefoot. I helped secure a new Reston railway station and **I've always backed the reinstatement of the Borders Railway**, helping secure £5m from the Scottish Government for a feasibility study to examine extension of the route to Hawick, Newcastleton and Carlisle. The climate emergency is real, so I'm proud to lead Scotland's energy transition, with 97% of Scotland's current electricity needs now able to be met by renewables.

I am proud of my record as a South Scotland MSP, but now I'm asking you - on the 6th May - to put your faith in me as your next constituency MSP. In return, you'll get a strong local representative who will listen, engage with you and work constructively in the best interests of all those who choose to make this beautiful constituency of ours their home.
