


ACHIEVEMENTS

THE BREXIT CHALLENGE

In 2016, UK Ministers disastrously decided to drag Scotland out of the EU, despite 58% of Borderers & 62% of Scotland's voters opting to remain in. Borders shellfish processors, farmers, & businesses now suffer higher costs & difficulties exporting goods.

Data from the UK Office of National Statistics, for this January, show an 83% drop in seafood exports and a 59% fall in meat exports compared with January 2020.

UK Ministers' broken promises on trade deals leave livestock farmers facing new threats; a desperate UK Government grasping for rushed trade deals risks allowing in products like hormone-injected beef, or chlorinated chicken, undermining Scottish farmers' higher animal welfare & food safety standards — standards that shoppers rely upon.

In 2014, opponents urged you to vote 'No' to Independence to 'guarantee' EU membership. Now all three London-controlled parties oppose rejoining the


Only one route can secure a chance to rejoin the EU market and its 450 million customers – voting SNP.


